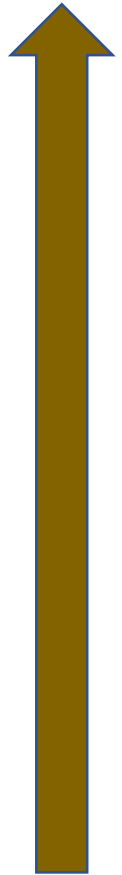

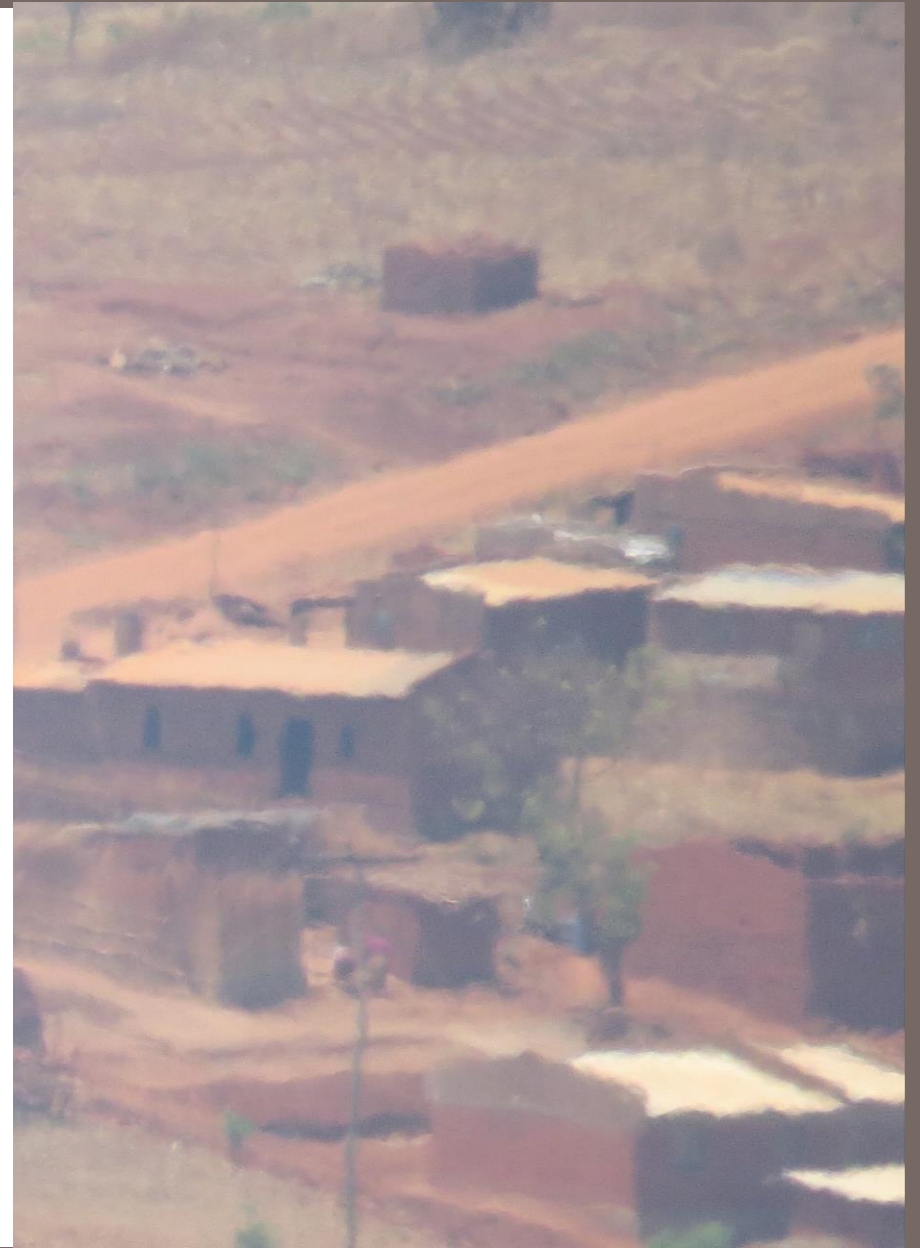

The sacred is...

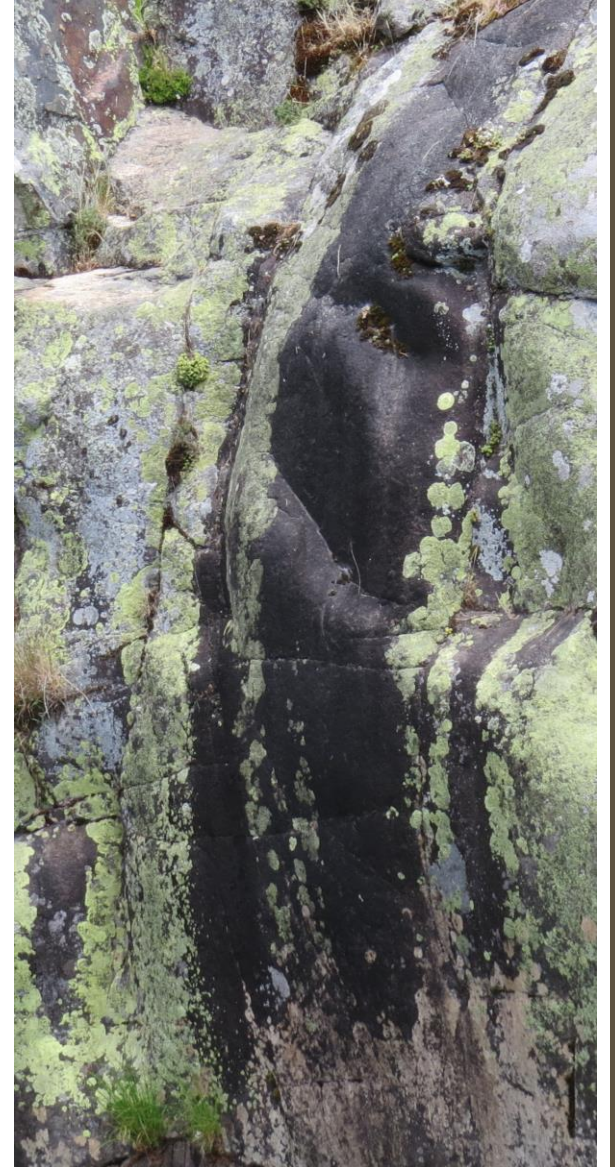
Inspiring and revealing
